

# IT Managers Group Terms of Reference

## 1 Purpose

The purpose of this document is to describe the Terms of Reference of the IT Managers Group.

## 2 Terms of Reference

*The mission of the IT Managers Group will be to:*

Influence the strategic direction of information and communications technologies (ICT) at a whole-of-government level, through the provision of considered and expert advice to both the Inter Agency Steering Committee (IASC) and those involved with ICT within the Tasmanian Government.

*The objectives of the IT Managers Group will be to:*

- Provide strategic advice and recommendations to the IASC in relation to ICT from a whole-of-government level and agency perspective;
- Pool knowledge, expertise and resources to improve ICT outcomes from a whole-of-government level and agency perspective;
- Promote innovation in the use of ICT;
- Promote the adoption of common practices and consistent approaches in ICT; and
- Act as reference and coordinating group for whole-of-government ICT projects.

A representative of the IASC will Chair the IT Managers Group. The agenda should be determined by the Chair in consultation with the Inter Agency Policy and Projects Unit (IAPPU), Department of Premier and Cabinet.

Membership of the IT Managers Group is open to inner-budget agencies of the Tasmanian Government. The IT Managers Group is expected to meet for one to two hours, six to eight times a year.

Agency representation for the IT Managers Group should be a position either at CIO, IT Director or IT Manager level, as determined by, and as appropriate to, each of the inner-budget agencies.

IAPPU will provide the Secretariat to support the operations of the IT Managers Group. The Minutes from each meeting will be provided to the IASC.
